Impact Statement is the topic for today. And other 5 subjects will not be allowed in this hearing. 6 7 Questions, interchanges, and discussions are not permitted in the hearing. And, again, there's 8 9 no presentation today. It's just for receiving 10 comments. Today's hearing, as well as those received 11 in writing, will be classified and recorded into 12 13 appropriate subject areas. All comments will be reviewed and subsequent comments will receive responses 14 and be documented in a final environmental impact 15 16 statement and record of the decision, anticipated to be 17 issued by the Federal Transit Administration later this 18 year. 19 This hearing, again, is being recorded by a 20 court reporter. All comments received are a matter of 21 public record. 2.2 It is now 12:15 p.m., Thursday, 23 June 25th, 2020. According to the requirements set forth in DART's enabling legislation, this public 24 25 hearing on the D2 Subway Supplemental Draft Environment
