The nation's largest contiguous urban arts district offers plenty to see,

including works by Picasso and Giacometti at the Nasher Sculpture Center. Nearby, you'll find restaurants and pubs perfect for your pre- or post-match plans.

Get there: Pearl/Arts District Station

Don't miss: Klyde Warren Park is a vibrant public space with food trucks and lots of free activities – such as soccer watch parties.

This neighborhood features turn-of-the-century red-brick warehouses and landmarks like The Sixth Floor

Museum at Dealey Plaza. The museum documents the life and assassination of John F. Kennedy. Nearby, you'll find modern restaurants and shops.

Get there: West End Station

Don't miss: The Dallas World Aquarium features a dramatic glass shark tunnel, while the Dallas Holocaust and Human Rights Museum examines the history of the Holocaust and advances human rights. A short walk away, the Perot Museum of Nature and Science has fascinating, family-friendly exhibits including *Soccer: More Than a Game*, which shows how physics, biology, and technology shape the world's favorite sport.

five world-class museums, striking modern architecture and rich Western heritage.

Get there: Fort Worth Central Station, then transfer to Trinity Metro's route 002 bus

Don't miss: The Kimbell Art Museum is renowned for its high-quality collection. The National Cowgirl Museum and Hall of Fame honors the pioneering spirit of women who shaped the American West.

Don't miss: Fair Park is home to one of the world's largest collections of art deco exposition architecture.

The Old West comes alive in this national historic district. See longhorns in a real cattle drive.

Two-step at authentic Texas dance halls. Chill with a cold one at a rustic saloon or shop for Western wear.

Get there: Fort Worth Central Station, then transfer to Trinity Metro's Orange Line bus

Don't miss: Cowtown Coliseum hosts a rodeo every Friday and Saturday night, and Billy Bob's Texas is known as "the world's largest honky-tonk."

BISHOP ARTS DISTRICT

Charming and Eclectic

This tree-lined neighborhood is full of restaurants, bars, shops and galleries

in 1920s-era storefronts and bungalows. The Dallas Streetcar, which departs within walking distance of EBJ Union Station, serves the district.

Get there: Dallas Streetcar Bishop Arts stop

Don't miss: Lockhart Smokehouse is a sure bet for real-deal, acclaimed Texas barbecue, while Wild Detectives combines a bookstore, a bar and a café under one roof.
