

The Downtown Garland Station is served by the Blue line. This station is in the heart of downtown Garland's cultural and commercial district. The landmark station emulates an old-fashioned train depot, and provides easy access to Garland's major civic landmarks, entertainment, and multifamily developments.

The city is embarking on a redevelopment of this area to transform the area into a destination for the community. Visitors and locals can expect to enjoy more recreational/ event space, open streetscapes and patio areas, children's play areas, water features, pavilions and a promenade.


