



ILLINOIS STATION



The Illinois Station is in the South Oak Cliff neighborhood, north of Illinois Avenue and east of Denley Drive. DART Police Headquarters is located at the station within the Monroe Shops building, which is on the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) because of its history as a repair shop for the Interurban rail line. The surrounding neighborhood is largely single-family and is sprinkled with churches, two elementary schools, a high school, and small businesses. The East Oak Cliff Trail is accessible to the south at Illinois Avenue. One of DART's first electric vehicle charging stations will be located at this station and open to the public in summer 2023.

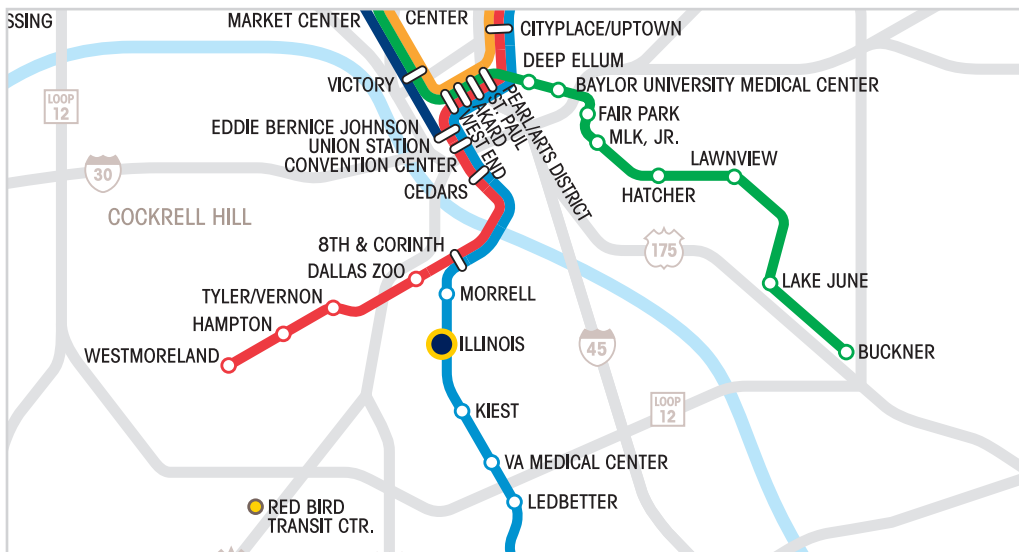
