

Station Facts

Located a few blocks from burgeoning downtown Plano, the 12th Street Station serves as a key component in the city's plan to expand its downtown area. The new aerial station at 12th Street will provide connections to the Silver Line and existing DART Orange and Red Line service.

Several shops, restaurants and historic landmarks are within walking distance of the 12th Street Station, including the historic Douglas Community – the oldest established African-American settlement in North Texas. The brick-lined streets elicit an old-world charm, connecting downtown Plano's history to its status as a suburban metropolis with easy transit access to the DFW area.
