

Station Facts

Located near the intersection of the President George Bush Turnpike and Central Expressway (US-75), the CityLine/Bush Station provides easy access to the adjacent CityLine development as well as connections to DART light rail transit into Plano and Dallas on the Orange and Red Lines.

CityLine serves as the business anchor to State Farm Insurance and Raytheon and includes several dining, retail and entertainment options. Residents in multifamily and single-family homes enjoy nearby Fox Creek Park and existing hike and bike trails that will connect to the Cotton Belt Regional Trail.
