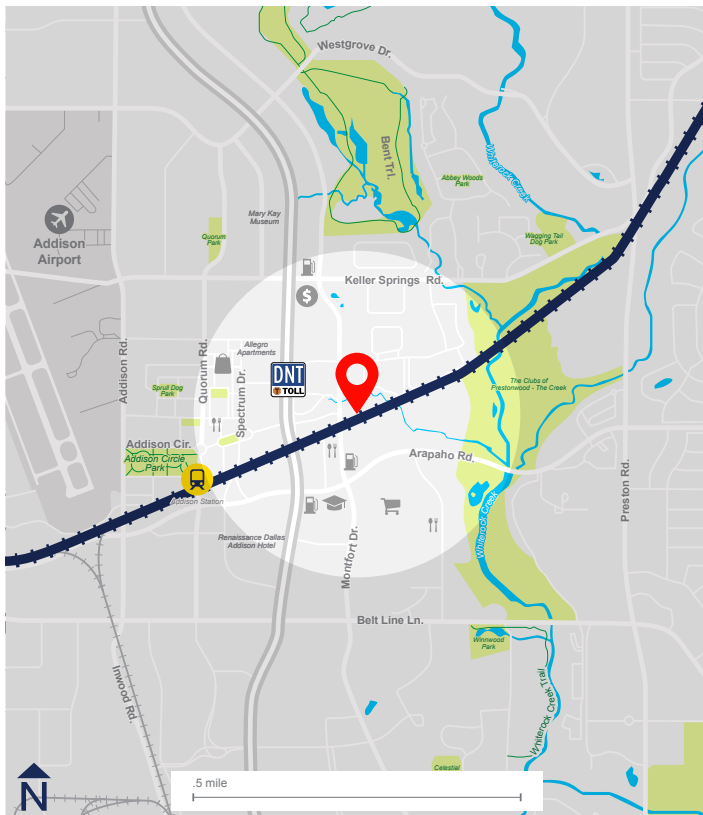

Station Facts

Located in the heart of the North Dallas business district, the Knoll Trail Station is a short walk from several apartment complexes and office buildings. A designated kiss-and-ride station, this Silver Line stop will have minimal parking and is one of only two Dallas stations.

The Knoll Trail Station is less than a half-mile from the popular Village on the Parkway retail center and Addison Circle Park, which can be accessed by the adjacent Cotton Belt Regional Trail.
