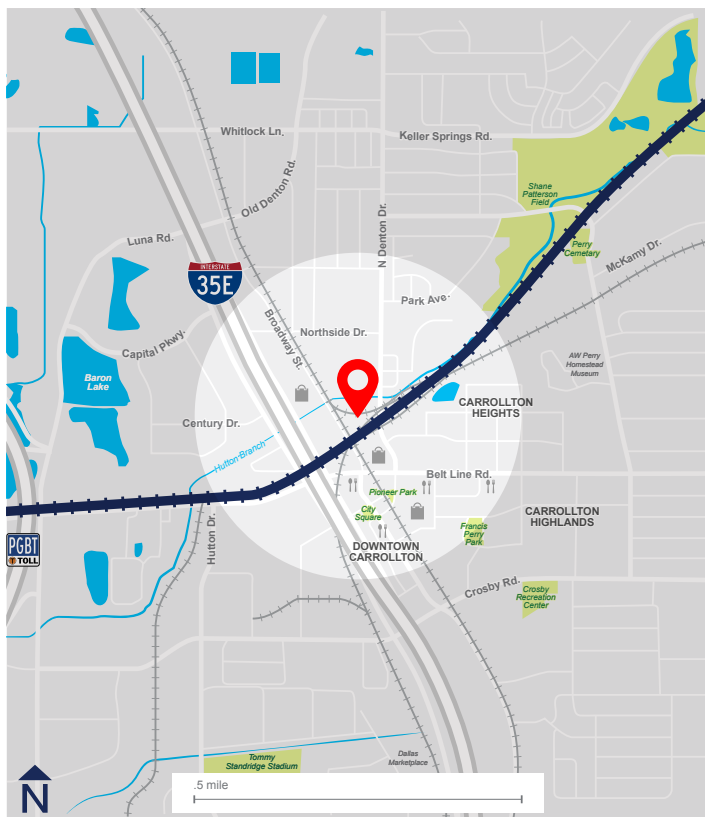

Station Facts

Located within walking distance of historic downtown Carrollton and with easy access to I-35, the Downtown Carrollton Station will be a major connection point for the area. Combined with the existing DART Green Line and future DCTA A-Train stations, the Silver Line Station will be a transit hub providing access to Denton, Plano, Dallas and Fort Worth.

Downtown Carrollton offers something for everyone with restaurants, shopping, services, hike and bike trail connectivity, and various housing options within walking distance. The downtown square district also serves as a popular spot for many of the city's festivals and seasonal celebrations.
