

Station Facts

Located within walking distance of the growing Cypress Waters area, the Cypress Waters Station is the first residential and business point for passengers leaving DFW Airport. The station will provide mobility access with DART bus connections for locals in the Dallas enclave and neighboring Coppell.

The largest master-planned lakeside community in the DFW area, Cypress Waters features 1,000 acres of office, retail, housing, and recreation amenities. Cypress Waters is also home to The Sound, which houses waterfront restaurants, shops, event space and a seasonal farmers market.
