

Station Facts

Located in the heart of the North Dalias business district, the Knoil Trail Station is a short walk from several apartment complexes and office buildings. A designated kiss-and-ride station, this Sliver Line stop will have minimal parking and is one of only two Dalias stations.

The Knoll Trail Station is less than a half-mile from the popular Village on the Parkway retail center and Addison Circle Park, which can be accessed by the adjacent Cotton Belt Regional Trail.






Cotton Belt Regional Trail

Built along the Silver Line corridor, the Cotton Belt Regional Trail is a project primarily funded by the North Central Texas Council of Governments.



Cotton Belt Regional Trail








Silver Line Vehicles

Silver Line's state-of-the-art vehicles require low maintenance, are diesel powered and meet strict EPA standards. The vehicles will feature:


- seating for 230+ passengers
- overhead storage, bike hooks, large luggage compartment
- internal and external closed-circuit television (CCTV) for consistent DART Police monitoring











Silver Line Testing Details

Testing of the vehicles is anticipated to begin in Q4 2024, and will include:

- Simulated service from DFW Airport Terminal B past **Knoll Trail Station** in Dallas.
- Stops at Knoll Trail, Addison, Carrollton, Cypress Waters and **DFW Airport North** stations.
- No passenger pick-up or drop-off.
- Testing of systems and crossings on track – flaggers when necessary.
- No Quiet Zones.





Recent In Progress Project Milestones

Data as of end of June 2024

- 8 Silver Line vehicles testing on TRE tracks, 2 vehicles moved to Silver Line corridor for testing in July.
- 95% of DNT Pedestrian Bridge is complete
- **90%** of Addison Station is complete
- 70% of Knoll Trail Station is complete
- 38 of 49 rail crossings are over 70% complete or completed
- 26 of 34 guideway bridges are over 80% complete or completed
- 6 of 7 pedestrian bridges are over 80% complete or completed
- 34 of 61 noise/betterment walls are over 80% installed
- 143,700+ linear feet of new track has been installed

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Silver Line Preliminary Operating Plan

Proposed daily service from DFW Airport to Shiloh Road with 55 to 60 trips includes:

- 5 a.m. to midnight
- 60-train schedule
- Trains every 30 minutes during peak weekday service times
- Trains every 60 minutes during all other weekday service times
- Weekend schedule hours still being studied
- Ability to adjust train schedule for special event service

Adoption of final service plan will come after public hearing and DART Board approval in 2025.



DART Fare Restructure

DART is engaging the community for comments regarding a proposed fare restructure. The agency will host community meetings throughout the service area. During these events, DART staff will outline the new fare proposal and receive your feedback.

This process will include a formal public hearing on Tuesday, Aug. 27, at 6 p.m. at DART Headquarters. (located at Akard Station – 1401 Pacific Ave., Dallas, TX, 75202)




