2024 DART STUDENT ART CONTEST GUIDELINES

DEADLINE: THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 29, 2024

- Designs must be original work created by the student and should illustrate the theme "Explore DART's 13 cities!" This contest is open to students in kindergarten through 12th grade. Limit one entry per student. No group entries allowed.
- Contestants must include the words "Explore DART's 13 cities!" somewhere in their submission. In addition, entries must incorporate DART into their design in some way. Examples could include using the DART logo, a DART vehicle, a DART facility and/or the word "DART" in their artwork.
- 3. Entries must measure 11" high x 17" wide, and designs should be laid out horizontally. Students may use multiple colors of their choice. Entries should be submitted on heavy paper such as poster, tag or illustration board.
- 4. All entries must include a completed entry form (see below). Affix the completed form to the back of the artwork. Entries must be mailed or delivered in person. Online entries will not be accepted. Entries may be picked up by DART staff, if requested. Entries must arrive no later than 5 p.m. on Thursday, February 29, 2024, and should be mailed to:

- Hand-delivered entries should be directed to DART Headquarters (Attention: Carlos Huerta), located at 1401 Pacific Ave., Dallas, TX 75202.
- 5. DART will notify the teachers or parents of the winners no later than Friday, April 5, 2024.
- 6. All artwork becomes the property of DART and may be used with appropriate credit to the artist. By entering the contest, you consent to have your name and photograph appear as one of the winners.
